

PETEX 2024 Abstract FAQs

We have provided some FAQs below to help answer the most common submission queries.

Who can submit an abstract?

We welcome submissions from Early Career Professionals alongside more experienced individuals and academics, working in the field of hydrocarbon as well as the broad range of cross-sector technologies, innovations and geoscience applications within the energy transition and associated industries.

How many abstracts can I submit?

There is no limit to the number of abstracts you can submit.

When is the abstract submission deadline?

The deadline for submitting your abstract is Friday 31st May 2024.

How do I submit my abstract?

We will only accept abstracts submitting through the Oxford Abstracts online platform here.

What is the word limit for the abstract submissions?

Abstracts should be a minimum of 500 words and a maximum of 2,000 words.

Can I include images and tables in my submission?

Yes, you may include images, equations, tables and charts in your abstract submission.

I'm not sure which theme to select for my abstract submission.

Can I make changes to my abstract once I have submitted it?

Yes, you can log back into your Oxford Abstracts account to make changes to your submission up until the submission deadline, Friday 31st May.

Can I withdraw my abstract once it has been submitted?

If you wish to withdraw your abstract, please contact events@ges-gb.org.uk quoting PETEX 2024 and your abstract submission number.

How will I know that my abstract has been successfully submitted?

Once you have clicked 'Submit' at the bottom of the abstract submission form, you will receive an email (to the email address used to log into your Oxford Abstracts account) to confirm your submission has been received.



Why is my abstract considered incomplete?

If you have received an email to inform you that your submission is incomplete, please log back into your Oxford Abstracts account and check you have completed all mandatory questions marked with an asterisk (*) on the submission form before the submission deadline.

When will I find out if my abstract has been accepted?

The submitting author will be notified by the end of July 2024 with the outcome of your abstract submission.

What are the presentation options if my abstract is accepted?

If your abstract is accepted for presentation at PETEX 2024, you will be offered either an oral or poster presentation.

If my abstract is accepted for poster, will I have to produce a physical poster, or will posters be presented electronically?

If your abstract is accepted for poster at PETEX 2024, you will need to produce a physical poster which will be displayed on poster boards at the venue.

If my abstract is accepted, do I still have to register and pay to attend PETEX 2024?

Yes, the presenting author must register and pay the discounted presenter fee.
